

Motor Vehicle Manufacturing

3361: Motor Vehicle Manufacturing: 33611 Automobile and Light Duty Motor Vehicle Manufacturing: This industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in (1) manufacturing complete automobile and light duty motor vehicles (i.e., body and chassis or uni-body) or (2) manufacturing chassis only. **33612 Heavy Duty Truck Manufacturing:** This industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in (1) manufacturing heavy duty truck chassis and assembling complete heavy duty trucks, buses, heavy duty motor homes, and other special purpose heavy duty motor vehicles for highway use or (2) manufacturing heavy duty truck chassis only.

Motor Vehicle Body and Trailer Manufacturing

3362 Motor Vehicle Body and Trailer Manufacturing This industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in (1) manufacturing motor vehicle bodies and cabs or (2) manufacturing truck, automobile and utility trailers, truck trailer chassis, detachable trailer bodies, and detachable trailer chassis. The products made may be sold separately or may be assembled on purchased chassis and sold as complete vehicles. Motor homes are units where the motor and the living quarters are contained in the same integrated unit, while travel trailers are designed to be towed by a motor unit, such as an automobile or a light truck.

Motor Vehicle Parts Manufacturing

33631 Motor Vehicle Gasoline Engine and Engine Parts Manufacturing: This industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in (1) manufacturing and/or rebuilding motor vehicle gasoline engines and engine parts and/or (2) manufacturing and/or rebuilding carburetors, pistons, piston rings, and engine valves, whether or not for vehicular use. **33632:Motor Vehicle Electrical and Electronic Equipment Manufacturing:** This industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing and/or rebuilding electrical and electronic equipment for motor vehicles and internal combustion engines. The products made can be used for all types of transportation equipment (i.e., aircraft, automobiles, trucks, trains, ships) or stationary internal combustion engine applications.






Development of Alabama's Agriculture Industry by Company






Development of Alabama's Agriculture Industry by Company






Development of Alabama's Agriculture Industry by Employment




Total Wages by NAICS Code 2000-2013





2013 Average Annual Employment by Age Group






3336 Engine, Turbine, and Power Transmission Equipment Manufacturing 2013 Average Annual Employment by Age Group






3361 Motor Vehicle Manufacturing 2013 Average Annual Employment by Age Group






3362 Motor Vehicle Body and Trailer Manufacturing 2013 Average Annual Employment by Age Group
